Joachim Romain - Photographer, plastic artist

My work is a mirror of my environment, my personal and artistic perception of the world surrounding me.

Born from the union of an art enthusiast and a photographer, Joachim Romain developed from his teenage years, tendencies to observe a desire to capture, through the use of photography, the moods of the advertising remains of the lanes of Le Havre, which is his birth place.

Later on, always on the look-out, he traveled across countries and cities, tirelessly capturing the evolution of the "monuments" of the street. He collected images of stratified advertising posters and eroding walls covered with graffiti, of accumu-


lations of paper and organic matter that were littering the ground or clinging to poles, railings, grills, promotional columns, wall-mounted gas boxes and electric meter boxes of the city.

He strolled the streets looking for heaps degraded by the hand of man, worn by the weather, decomposed by time.

Then, he went deeper into the bowels of the city. Through his clandestine and solitary excursions of abandoned places,

disused tunnels, construction sites, catacombs... this urban explorer infiltrates to better master the modern city and its backstage.

In his Fast_Shop series, the artist draws on his intuitions and sensations about the frenetic and hypnotic impulses caused by the online purchase. Indeed, the rise of new technologies and the virtual have allowed brands to develop globally via the medium of the web. E-merchandising has spread and now offers consumers dematerialized commercial transactions and more exhaustive choices than what a real store can offer. Humans can thus, without moving, save time, compare product prices and thus benefit from the best offers, but they can also benefit from other customers' opinions, buy easily abroad and access in a few clicks to a wider range of products than in the shops.



Clutching the mouse wheel, humans quickly fly over the size, the color, the material, and all the other marketing options supposed to guide them - or disorient them - in their online purchase, without even realizing that they are forcing their ankylosed bodies to a stream of pages and articles at an almost epileptic speed.

For this work, Joachim Romain applied himself to navigate on online stores by collecting, classifying, archiving bookmarks, hacking locally the pages to modify the

html code of the sites and thus modify their graphic charter as he pleased. Then he took pictures from his computer screen to capture the essence and energy of the essence and the energy of our delirious pace to always consume quicker. He placed his camera on a tripod in front of the computer and shot the pages of these virtual stores in long pause, taking care, by means of the cursor, to move the image on the screen, thus creating random forms and colors, analogous to this sensation of profusion and speed.

Layering, repetitions, fuzziness, aberrations of colors, dead pixels, unhinged compositions, multiplications, inks saturations... these are the results to his intentional mu-tation - unintentional - to express our purchase habits in the virtual world. He then twisted, burned, ripped, painted, stuck the pictures achieved to sculpt his own prints and recreate on "canvas" the urban wear of the streets, from which his art originates.

We are in the infinite moment Fast Shop by Joachim Romain

Acceleration is the major experience that we face at Joachim Romain's Fast Shop. Fast shops are the photographs that capture the scrolling movement of e-shop web pages. By pointing his camera at the web screen scrolled by his computer mouse, Joachim Romain creates a photograph that confronts the infinite flow of the internet with the photographic box. An unusual confrontation between the digital screen and the capture of this surface by the camera, his approach produces photographs that capture the acceleration of our society. This contemporary world which is racing and which produces this headlong rush which always runs faster and faster as man runs out of steam.

Incompressible in a shot, the Fast Shop photo seems to slip from its support. The speed glitches these moments of internet consumption. Scroll and consume.

From collage to photography, Joachim Romain produces works representing the moment when flows of digital information accumulate, mix and become as compressed as they are unreadable.

No retouching is made to these photos, Joachim Romain adopts a photographic technique that is as innovative as it is low tech. It produces an image freezing the infinite acceleration of the digital world in one click.






